1. **Attend your precinct meeting** the evening of Tuesday, January 29th, 2019 (Check website, some precincts are on a different day) where you can be elected as a Precinct Leader, and/or to serve as a delegate to the County Convention on Saturday, February 23rd.

If you can't attend your precinct meeting, you can still serve as a delegate to the county convention by contacting your Precinct Chairman, or any other member of your precinct you know will be attending your precinct's meeting and ask them to place your name on the list of those wanting to serve as a delegate to the County Convention (Those who attend a precinct meeting will vote to elect Precinct Officers to serve until the 2021 precinct meetings).

2. **Not all precincts have a Chairman,** however, you are not in this alone. Go to the website FIRST www.tulsagop.org and check where your precinct meeting is located. We will have representatives at your location to help you in this process. IF you have no Precinct Chairman to guide you, we will help. Also, feel free to contact the office this week, BEFORE the meeting, for information 918.627.5702. You are NOT alone in this, we will have people available to help you.
3. **If you don't know your precinct number,** go to www.ok.gov/elections, click "Online Voter Tool", click "Online Voter Tool" AGAIN, fill out the personal information required and click "Search".

You can call the Tulsa County Election Board at 918.596.5780. They can look up your precinct number based on your current residential address.

4. **IMPORTANT:** To be considered a “member” of your precinct eligible to vote on any matters presented at your precinct’s meeting, you must meet two qualifying criteria:
- (a) you must be **registered** as a **Republican** in the precinct; and
 - (b) **currently** be **residing** in the precinct.

If you moved and have not changed your registration at the Tulsa County Election Board to reflect your new address, you will not qualify as a “member” of the precinct where you reside or the precinct where you resided prior to moving.

5. **You MUST bring your Voter ID Card** with you to your precinct’s meeting. If you need a new Voter ID Card, contact the Tulsa County Election Board at 918.596.5780. They can mail you a new card, but we SUGGEST you pick it up at their location, 555 N. Denver, Tulsa.
6. **Attend the Tulsa County Convention:** and, further authorized by the convention delegates to serve as a delegate at the State Convention in Moore, Oklahoma on Saturday, April 6th, 2019, representing Tulsa County.

In recent years the delegates to the County Convention have voted to authorize anyone selected by their precincts to serve as a delegate to the County Convention to be authorized to serve as a delegate to the State Convention, even if they were not able to attend the County Convention.
